How to do your PhD successfully (for new and advanced PhD-students)

Between 30 and 50 % of all PhD students in Germany do not finish their doctoral theses. There are many reasons for that, but most of them can be eliminated: if you have done a master's or similar degree with good results you will be able to do a PhD too.

- How to define and set goals, do time planning and time management

- Do's and Don'ts for PhD-students
