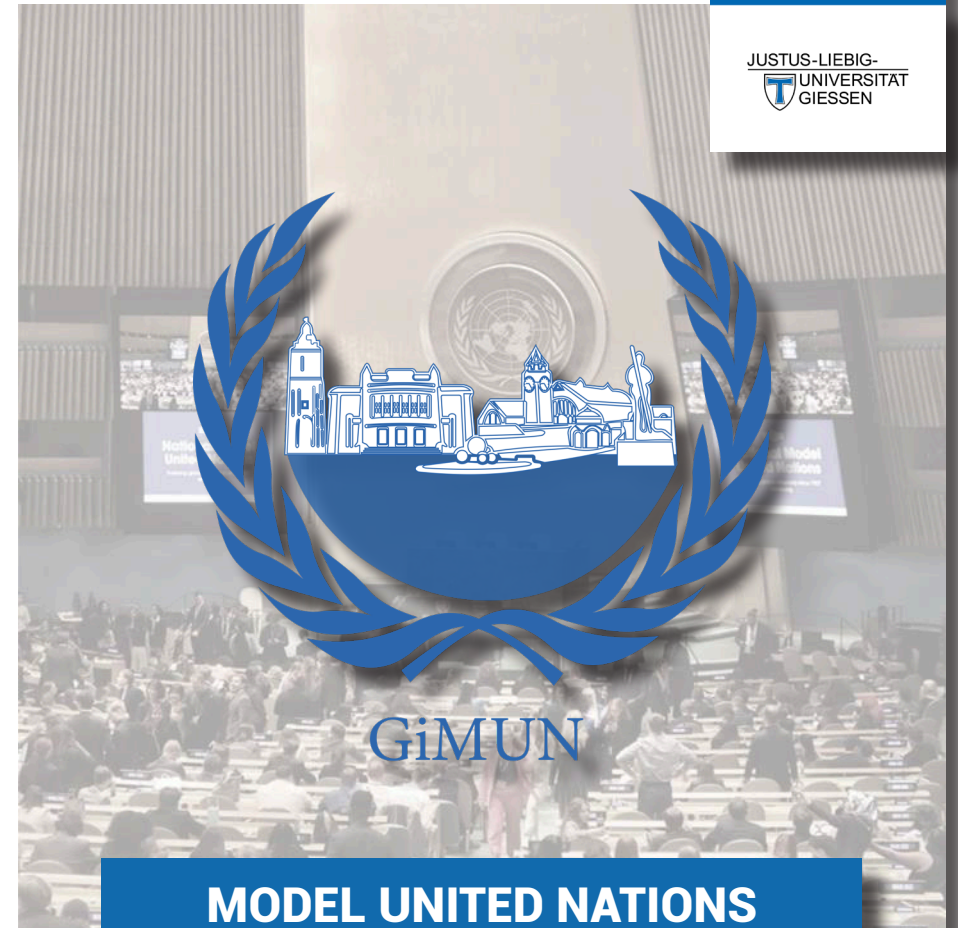

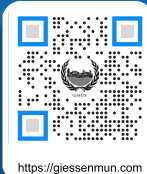
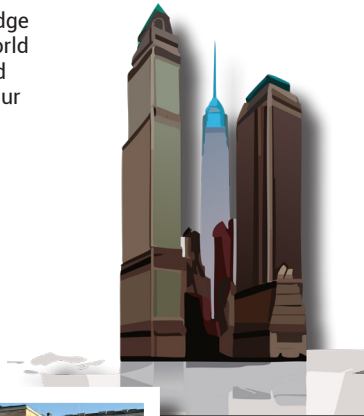

## What is Model United Nations?

Model United Nations (MUN) is a simulation of the United Nations. Students take on the role of diplomats, discuss current topics and work on resolutions in different UN Committees. The conferences are held in English and take place all over the world. During the winter semester of 2025/26, we will be preparing a new delegation from Giessen University to be sent to National Model United Nations in New York (NMUN) in March/April 2026.

## Why should you apply?

By participating in the project, you can broaden your knowledge on public international law with practical insights into the world of diplomacy. You can learn more about the history, work and main fields of work of the United Nations, while improving your rhetorical and negotiating skills. The conference is also a platform for meeting other students from different countries.



## Who can participate?

Students from all faculties who are interested in international politics and the United Nations are welcome to apply.

Law students will be able to acquire a Fremdsprachenschein or Schlüsselqualifikation and the preparatory colloquium is further considered a Wahlveranstaltung for Schwerpunktbereich 6 (International Law and European Law).

## Costs

Co-payment is anticipated to be around 500€, in exceptional cases further assistance can be provided.

## Preparation

Mandatory, in-person weekly colloquium in English, and participation in SiegMUN and/or MainMUN as well as a mandatory study trip to Berlin.
