Course description: The course will deal with selected topics in Industrial Organization. It consists of two parts:

 A two day block course on Behavioral IO taught by Professor Paul Heidhues, University of Düsseldorf. An introduction to the respective literature can be found in Spiegler, Ran (2011): Bounded rationality and industrial organization. Oxford: Oxford Univ. Press.

2. The second part of the course consists of two full-day course meetings, in which we discuss both potential applications of that framework and where participants have the opportunity to present their own research. The topics of these presentations are not restricted to behavioral IO models.

Credits for the course: PhD-students who participate all four days of the course and present own research or work in progress earn 6 ECTS.
