

Call for Papers Young Journal of European Affairs (YJEA)

The Young Journal of European Affairs (YJEA) is looking for your contributions to its **third issue in 2023!** The YJEA was founded at the University of Munich in 2020 and has since successfully published yearly issues, co-organised a student conference, established a blog on EU policy and worked with experienced academics from around the world to provide high quality feedback students would rarely receive elsewhere. We allow students to publish their papers on EU affairs from the very beginning of their academic careers and provide them with the rigorous challenge to show seasoned scholars the potential of their work and with opportunities to learn key qualifications during their education, which are relevant for future career opportunities – especially in academia. You want to benefit from that experience as well? Then submit your paper and work with us to potentially share your ideas with the world!

Is there a deadline for submissions? There is a priority deadline on the **01. April 2023**. If you submit by then, you will have considerably more time to work on revisions (six instead of four weeks) and to better reconcile the publication process with other commitments. Moreover, you will increase your chances of being published in the third issue by giving yourself more time to complete all the necessary revisions in time. Most importantly, when the publication is approaching and we have to choose between articles of similar quality, yours will be prioritised. The main deadline is the **01. June 2023**. We recommend submitting by our priority deadline, but no later than the 01. June.

Who can publish and what can be published? We accept submissions from **students currently pursuing a bachelor's or master's degree**. Papers submitted by PhD candidates will not be accepted, unless they were written during their bachelor's or master's studies. [Submit](#) your pieces on European politics, mainly but not exclusively, in the **following fields of study**:

- European Public Policy
- European Integration
- European Foreign, Security and Defence Policy
- European Political Economy
- Global Governance Perspectives on the EU

You will benefit from our double-blind peer-reviewing procedure, which is in line with the highest academic standards of quality assurance and used in most senior journals. The Editorial Board of the YJEA as well as experienced scholars will give you detailed feedback on your work and help out with advice for the revision.

We exclusively accept academic articles. Shorter opinion pieces can be submitted for publication on the YJEA blog at board@yjea.org. Articles might have been written as, for instance, coursework for university, your bachelor's or master's dissertation or as independent work. Please notice the format requirements on our [website](#).

There is no guarantee that your manuscript will be published. This depends on the outcome of the peer-reviewing. The review process might take six months or more.
