Antiziganism is still widespread today and particularly affects Sinti*ze and Rom*nja as members of Europe's largest minority. Nevertheless, the topic is largely neglected in both academia and society. Drawing on critical social theory, Laura Soréna Tittel combines reflections on the function of the “gypsy” figure in the political theory of Kant, Marx, and Adorno with extensive source material ranging from early modern legal texts to images used by the police. She traces the origins of modern antiziganism in the Enlightenment, capitalism, and state formation, thus enabling critical perspectives on a societal relationship of domination.
