Housing proposal will be made upon reception of all requested documents listed on the university website.</p>

INSURANCE

Fall semester and full academic year	<p>EUROPEAN STUDENTS : European students must hold the European health insurance card. http://www.univ-orleans.fr/sites/default/files/INTERNATIONAL/documents/assurance_sante_gbbs.pdf</p> <p>NON EUROPEAN STUDENTS : Students will need a private health insurance covering for medical expenses and repatriation until October 1st. After the 1st of October, they will be covered by the French student social security, that will have to be paid upon registration. http://www.univ-orleans.fr/sites/default/files/INTERNATIONAL/documents/assurance_sante_gbbs.pdf</p>
Spring semester	<p>NON EUROPEAN STUDENTS will have to pay the compulsory French student social security valid only after registration. Therefore we advise students, to get a private health insurance covering for medical expenses and repatriation for two months.</p>

	<p>✓ Courses are taught in French, a B1 level is required. Please note that IBAT, PROD, PEIP programmes are not available to exchange students.</p>
	<p>✓ Some courses can be taught in English only during the fall semester of the 5th year- Master 2 a B1 level is required:</p> <p>✓ Personal Projects (PP) can be done in English.
