Project:

The World Cancer Research Fund (WCRF) identified twelve cancers where overweight or obesity are at least "probable" risk-increasing exposures, including breast, endometrial, and ovarian cancers. Our research group is conducting a systematic review to summarize the evidence on the mechanisms underlying these associations in women. We aim to investigate (i) sex steroid hormones, (ii) inflammation, and (iii) insulin and insulin-like growth factors (IGF) as intermediate mechanistic pathways linking body fatness and cancer risk.

Internship Description:

- Literature search on project-associated topics
- Screening of studies based on specific inclusion/exclusion criteria
- Extracting data of relevant studies
- Data analysis using Excel, SAS and R
- Summarizing and describing the results of the data analysis
