Formal criteria

- No more than 1 year of work on your PhD project
- Fluency in German OR English
 During the membership you are expected to learn / improve the other language
- Final university transcript/certificate until
 30 September 2024 at the latest

Criteria of evaluation

- Quality of research proposal
- Fit of project with GCSC research profile
- Excellent marks in a two-year research-track MA programme (equivalent to German 2,0 and up)
- Interdisciplinarity of project
- International orientation of project
- Can be supervised at JLU

- Brief applications

 (abstract, CV, letter of motivation, LOR)
- Reviewed by Selection Committee

2nd stage

- Full applications
 with research
 proposal, work
 plan,
 certificates,
 MA thesis**
- 2 reviewers and Selection Committee

3rd stage

- Interviews with Selection Committee (professors, Postdocs, PhD Students, EOC rep)
- Final decision by SelCom

** For MA theses written in languages other than English or German, please submit your original thesis as well as a summary (2 pages, see FAQ).

 - Letter of Motivation
 - CV
 - Letters of Recommendation

Your letter of motivation

- Introduce yourself
- Why are you applying at the GCSC?
- How does your project contribute to the GCSC's research profile?
- Watch out for language and style

Your abstract

- Ca. 500 words
- Working title and research question / aim
- Methodology and theory
- Succinct and clear
- Well-structured
- Make us curious about your project!

Your CV

- Tabular
- Well-structured
- No unexplained gaps
- Up-to-date
- Includes date

It should include:

- academic and employment history
- final examinations (incl. grade)
- international experience
- volunteer / community engagement

It may include:

- personal data (date of birth, family status)
- additional qualifications (if applicable)

International PhD Programme Literary and Cultural Studies

Your letters of recommendation

Formalities:

- Official stationery with contact information of referee
- At least 1 letter from a full professor (holding a chair); second referee PhD+
- Must be up-to-date!

Content:

- How do they know you?
- Assessment of your ability to work academically, your aptitude and experience in your subject
- No need to comment on your PhD project

Second Stage: Deadline 12 March 2024

Send as PDFs to gcsc-application@gcsc.uni-giessen.de:

- Certificates: high school (e.g. A levels) and university (certified copies not necessary)
- Research proposal (max. 10 pages plus bibliography)
- Detailed work plan and schedule, ca. 1-2 pages
- MA thesis / final thesis

Criteria for excellent research proposals

- Innovative research question(s)
- Familiarity with the subject area/topic
 - Situates project within current scholarship
 - Knowledge of relevant sources and literature
- Interdisciplinarity / relevance for GCSC's research profile
- Well-thought-out and plausible argument
- Clear structure
- Knowledge of academic style and language

- Central and innovative research question
- Succinct summary of project aims and goals
- Describes topicality, impact, and ,added value' of project
- Feasibility in 3 years
- Catch your readers' interest!

The literature review

 Concise, targeted presentation of relevant scholarship and current literature

Highlight connections to your own project

- Demonstrate ,added value', impact, topicality
- Highlight new research directions



- More detailed explanation of individual steps in accordance with work plan
- Justification of source selection, sample, object of investigation
- Concrete examples illustrating main hypotheses or arguments
- Goal-oriented (research) questions

Situating within GCSC profile



- Which research areas, ETRGs, AGs etc. does your project contribute to?
- How does it engage with concepts, theories, methods already employed within research being conducted at the GCSC?

Your work plan

- Covering 3 years
- Ideally 2-4 months per item
- Most important steps in keywords
- Including planned field trips / stays outside Germany
- Ca. 1-2 pages
- Not incorporating the GCSC curriculum

Third stage: Interviews

Successful candidates will be invited to a **30-minute online interview**.

Interview Procedure

You decide whether the interview takes place in German or English. You may be asked a question in the other language.

- 5-min presentation of your project
 - Contribution to the GCSC's research profile
 - Situate yourself within the RAs / ETRGs
 - Method & methodology
- Selection Committee asks questions about your project
- Time for your own question(s)

GCSC Scholarship

Fully funded membership

- Up to 6 scholarships of 1.468 €/month (incl. 103 € flat material cost)
- For up to 3 years
- 1 additional year for children aged <12;
 +400 € for child <18, +100 € for each
 additional child
- Financial support for research trips and language courses

GCSC Membership

Partially funded membership

- Financial support for research trips and language courses
- Scholarship advice

- GCSC Teaching Centre: support in planning seminars and other didactic matters
- GCSC Career Service: preparation for further career

Requirements and expectations

All members, incl. scholarship holders:

- Independent work on a PhD project that makes a recognisable contribution to the GCSC's research profile and that can be supervised at Justus Liebig University (first supervisor)
- Engagement in the GCSC's Research Areas (initiation, co-ordination and documentation of collaborative research projects, e. g. conferences, workshops, publications)
- Active participation in the GCSC's curriculum

Scholarship holders are expected to play an **especially active part** in the coordination and documentation of activities within the Research Areas.

Membership application

- GCSC online application form (see website) in English OR German
- Covering letter incl. your motivation for applying at the GCSC
- CV and copies of all transcripts and certificates
- Research proposal (max. 10 pages), which also situates your project within the GCSC's research profile
- Work plan covering 3 years
- For JLU PhD students: letter of recommendation from first supervisor, which comments on research proposal and work plan and explicitly endorses GCSC membership
- For other applicants: two letters of recommendation from professors at your home institution

Submit via e-mail or snail mail.

Other funding options

- External doctoral scholarship

 GCSC members receive advice and support in their search for scholarships
- Working in our outside of academia

Less time for your PhD, but potentially holding a job you enjoy / that prepares you for your future career. GCSC members holding a job can extend their membership for up to one additional year.

External scholarships

Financial support

Monthly grant covering living expenses

Additional money for research and family allowance often possible

Usually for 2 years (+ 1 year extension)

Academic / ideational support

Summer schools / seminars, interdisciplinary colloquia

Workshops (e.g. career counseling & leadership skills)

Excellent research network, liaison lecturers / professors at universities

Peer network

Potential contacts in industry, politics, media
