Videoconference-Systems

- Cisco Webex: Update on March 16, 2021 for the Desktop-App of Cisco Webex to Version 41.3. No restrictions in the operation of the application are expected while the update is being performed. The update includes the following features:
- Q&A: As part of our continued effort to bring training features into meetings as standard functionality, Q&A is now supported in Webex Meetings. Meeting participants can type their questions into the Q&A panel, which can be answered by the host or cohosts.
- Pre-meeting lobby: Webex scheduled meetings now have a pre-meeting lobby, just like Personal Room meetings. When attendees try to join a meeting, they can wait in a lobby if the meeting hasn't yet started. Once the host or cohost starts the meeting, they will enter the meeting based on meeting security settings.
- Enhancements to the Guest Join Experience: Currently, when guests join a meeting using the Webex app, they're asked for their display name or email address, and then the meeting preview window appears. With this update, guests now enter their information within the preview window. You can choose if you want the Webex app to remember your information or the account sign-in status. This reduces the time and steps to enter a meeting.
- The license for cisco webex beyond April 14, 2021 is contemplated and in process.
