Conference organisers: National University of Kyiv-Mohyla Academy (Ukraine), the Justus Liebig University Giessen (Germany), and O.O. Potebnia Institute of Linguistics of the National Academy of Science of Ukraine (Ukraine).

We welcome contributions that deal with theoretical, methodological, or empirical issues. The topics of the conference include, but are by no means limited to:

- language – culture – identity
- issues of postcolonial linguistics
- language – cognition – communication
- the Ukrainian language in the social and cultural space
- the functional aspect of language and the change of scientific paradigms
- issues of contrastive linguistics
- issues of applied linguistics

The conference includes a **panel discussion “Urban Language Space”** which aims to intensify research into urban oral and written speech in different regions of Ukraine, in particular, the problems of the functioning of standard Ukrainian, territorial and social varieties of the Ukrainian language, their interaction with each other and with the languages of other nations.

Call for Papers

The editors of “*Language: Classic – Modern – Postmodern*” are issuing a call for papers for the forthcoming issue of the journal to be printed in 2024. “*Language: Classic – Modern – Postmodern*” is an academic peer-reviewed open access journal publishing research papers in *linguistics* (<http://lcmp.ukma.edu.ua>).

We invite contributions focusing on, but not limited to, the questions of linguistic semantics and pragmatics; topical issues of grammar; cognitive linguistics; problems of text linguistics and discoursology; history of language, dialectology; sociolinguistics; comparative and translation studies.

Potential contributors are reminded that “*Language: Classic – Modern – Postmodern*” (LCMP) operates a two-stage peer review process. The first is based on the submission of detailed proposals (up to 1,000 words) and results in invitations to submit full articles from which a final selection is then made. The deadline for article proposals for this volume is **30 June 2024**, with further submission of completed articles, and publication in **Volume 10 (2024)**.

Submission fee: there is no submission fee and no paper processing charges.
The publication fee: **free of charge**.

To be considered for publication the manuscripts must meet the journal's technical and academic requirements, demonstrate research novelty, theoretical and applied significance of the research, and evidence of the author's knowledge of the state of the art on the subject of research.
