Transition Management addresses the enormous economic and political transformations we observe in many transition and emerging economies worldwide. Their societies are changing from state management to a market economy, from autocracy to democracy, often at a rapid pace and at higher income and technology levels than in a typical developing country.

WHAT MAKES US SPECIAL

Justus Liebig University Giessen (JLU) offers an international master's degree programme in Transition Management addressing the specific problems of transition countries in an international, interdisciplinary study course, combining both theory and practical experience. Five faculties of the university take part in the interdisciplinary master's degree programme Transition Management. The programme deals with the specific challenges in the countries commonly known as transition countries. These may be triggered by political upheaval, resource booms or technological change. The students develop a sound understanding of the complex processes and the specific requirements in transition countries and learn methods and strategies to improve transformational processes.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- A bachelor's degree with at least 180 ECTS credits in agriculture, nutrition, natural or environmental sciences, economics, law, or political science. Applications without a relevant bachelor's degree will be examined individually as to whether the study requirements are fulfilled.

- Proof of English language proficiency: TOEFL score of at least 550 (PBT), 213 (CBT), 80 (iBt) or IELTS score of at least 6 (Academic Training)

COMPOSITION OF THE STUDY PROGRAMME

The international degree programme in Transition Management has a standard period of study of four semesters. The programme starts each winter semester (October).

The modularised structure of the programmes allows for efficient studying and maximum flexibility. The course consists of eight mandatory modules (core modules) and eight optional modules (profile modules) and a master's thesis. Profile modules can be chosen from a wide range of modules. Thus, students are able to shape their professional profile according to their individual desires and requirements. The concept of choosing profile modules individually enables students to select from a diverse range of study areas on top of a fundamental scientific education represented by the core modules. an internship, which gives students the opportunity to come into direct contact with potential employers and gain practical experiences.

CAREER OPTIONS

Graduates of Transition Management work as project managers and consultants in private and public organisations involved in transition and development cooperation at national, supranational and international levels. They find employment as managers and specialists in private enterprises, like in the agricultural and nutritional sector, trade, banks, and financial services. During the degree programme, the students acquire various key qualifications that prepare them for high-quality employment. They include organisational and communicative skills, problem-solving methods, teamwork, innovativeness and flexibility.
