Gansu Province is located at the upstream of the Yellow River, winding more than 1600 kilometers from the east to the west. It is the intersection zone of Qinghai-Xizang plateau, the Loess plateau and Inner Mongolian plateau like the shape of jade Ruyi, meaning good luck and blessing. The landform is so diverse, including grasslands and mountains, glaciers and rivers, Gobi desert......Being colorful not only in the land view, it is also blessed as the cradles of traditional Chinese culture and enriches with a splendid cultures of 54 ethnic groups among all 56 Chinese peoples.






2024 LZU-ISP






