- The internship can start at earliest on 01.06.2021 The duration of the internship can be between 2 and 4 months.


# GENERAL OBJECTIVE OF POSITION

Will be taught the function of European projects, as the accent is on the bond between politics, programs and projects of the EU. The internship will help the development of practical skills for preparation of projects. During the internship will be learned the main steps for the successful development of an European projects.

Decrease the level of social exclusion and increase the social life of youngsters using non-formal education programmes that provide personal(self-confidence and self-esteem, independence, adaptability, creativity and ability to innovate, personal expression, sociability) and professional development.







Coordination and exchange are keywords in this internship. There are many learning opportunities for the interns like discovering many kinds of arts, new skills, a new language, involving children and youngsters in creative sessions and take responsibility to realise an our projects. The intern will learn how projects are set up, how sessions and workshops are concepted, what methodology we use for art education, how they can organise and take responsibilities themselves in projects, courses or sessions. The intern will mostly work with young people and will be participating in workshops with them, but also get the opportunity to work together with them on our local, national and international projects.

In the end of the internship the participants will have main knowledge for the EU politics and strategies. They will gain practical skills in management of European projects. They will be able to develop project ideas alone or in teamwork.







Razboyna is located 37 km away from Sunny Beach
























## 2. Phases of performance:

#### 4. Financial part

We strongly share European values and rely on the solidarity of our European peers, who provide high knowledge and culture and skills to come to our country and demonstrate the strength of the United Europe and together prove to Eurosceptics that young people can continue to offer Europe. Through this summer academy together we will change for the good life of at least *150 young people* with fewer opportunity and at risk of poverty.

## 5. Logic of implementation

Arriving in the town of Svishtov and going through training for organizing youth educational activities through the approach of non-formal way of education. Then the participants will be divided into teams and each place will have *from 2 to 4 members* visit different places in Bulgaria, such as: (photos from Sunny Beach, the Rhodopes, Isperih)

#### 6. Food and accommodation

Participants buy their own food from the scholarships. Accommodation and transport: 200 euros per month. We will provide them with accommodation in double rooms and provide them with a car to travel with.

7. Every week they will deal with children for 4 days, and for three days they will have the opportunity to get to know Bulgaria. They will work with the children for 8 hours a day.
