Transfer of skills and knowledge, a culture of learning with and from each other


Various groups of so called ,disadvantaged students will be brought into contact to learn from and with each other. A variety of social integrative activities will take place at the Lokal International and are intended to create understanding between the participants.


Students are supported by presentations, lectures and training sessions to be offered in cooperation with, for example, the ZfbK (Centre for Competences in Foreign Language and Vocational Skills) or the university team of the local job centre.

Subjects offered:

- academic writing
- applying for a placement or a job
- preparation for various fields of work (lectures in vocational orientation offered by the ZfbK)







"Im Gepäck... Visiting Scholars Share Their Stories"

International guest scholars talk about their home countries, their work, and their research, and share their intercultural and 'German' experiences.

Within this 'informal lecture', followed by an open discussion we translate our concept of transfer into practice. Students get the possibility of talking to international scholars and speaking about every subject which might be of interest.


Extending the Welcoming Service
