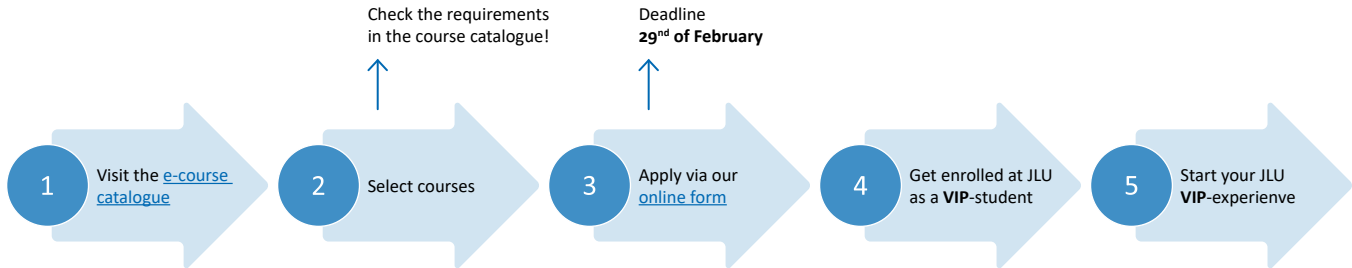

6. ONLINE ORIENTATION WEEK FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS (OWIS)

7. ACCOMPANYING PROGRAMME

- The International Office organises the Ultimate Get-together, weekly student-to-student online meetings, and a twice-monthly Question Monday. The programme is published monthly and invites you to get to know each other and network. You'll have the opportunity to meet JLU students and other international students in an informal setting at the Online Language Café or at the Quiz Night. Our Student Assistants are always keen to hear from enthusiastic students, so you are very welcome to contribute your own ideas to the programme planning during the semester!



- The Workshop Series on Academic Writing is specifically designed for international students. Organized in collaboration with JLU's Centre for Competence Development, the series is led by experts in academic writing. Three 1.5 hour workshops are held each semester to help students develop their academic writing skills and support them in organising and writing academic papers. The workshops are free for VIP students and are scheduled so that they can be attended in addition to the VIP courses.



- During the application process and throughout the semester, we offer online consultations. In Stud.IP (Teaching and Learning Platform) we set up a VIP-Group for students each semester where we provide you with important information. Stud.IP also offers the option to chat with each other using Blubber, so that VIP students can get in touch with each other regardless of their chosen course.



- Weekly Newsletter with information about studying at JLU, important event information for you and little anecdotes about cultural peculiarities of the Hessians and Germans.
