Individual support services

- Guaranteed accommodation in a student hall of residence

Partial scholarships

Graduates of our partner schools can apply for a 12-month partial scholarship of 400€ per month. The scholarships will be announced each year in April (2023-2025).





Prerequisites for study admission

- · High school diploma/Abitur
- · Proof of sufficient language knowledge:
 - → German C1 C2 (e.g. German Language Diploma Level II, DSD II)
 - → Optional offer for applicants: German intensive courses for preparation of academic studies at JLU
 - → English B2 C1
- · Check the requirements for your chosen study programme

Application for admission to studies

- With a foreign university entrance certificate apply via the online portal uni-assist
- With a German university entrance certificate apply via JLU's application portal
- Exception: Restricted admission programmes
 - → With a foreign university entrance certificate apply via uni-assist or hochschulstart, depending on the citizenship
 - → With a German university entrance certificate apply via hochschulstart and JLU's application portal
- Translation of documents to German or English
- Upload all necessary documents within the deadline
- After being admitted: Complete all required steps to enrol



IMPORTANT DATES FOR YOUR STUDIES AT JLU

- 15th July: Application deadline for restricted admission programmes (Winter Semester)
- 15th August: Application deadline for non-restricted programmes
- 1st October: Start of the Winter Semester
- 15th January: Application deadline for restricted programmes (Summer Semester)
- 28th February: Application deadline for non-restricted programmes
- 1st April: Start of the Summer Semester
- First week of each semester: Orientation Week for International Students (OWIS)
