First of all, send your application to the professor of your choice at one of <u>JLU's faculties</u> or to one of our renowned doctoral programmes.

Should you decide to enrol for your doctoral studies (which may not be necessary), you have to apply through the JLU application portal at: <u>https://bewerbung.uni-giessen.de</u>. You will need to upload the following documents:

•an officially certified copy (in either English or German) of your school-leaving certificate and of your bachelor and master degree certificates, including a full academic transcript

#### •CV

•the letter of consent from your supervisor (a short letter from your supervisor at JLU Giessen stating that s/he is willing to act as your academic supervisor) or a letter of admission from the respective doctoral study programme

## **Our Support Services**

The Support Services for International Doctoral Students will be happy to assist you during all phases of your doctoral studies: from the first steps, such as finding a supervisor, up to your thesis defence. We can be reached via email, phone and of course in person for a confidential consultation. Do not hesitate to contact us if you have any questions.

#### We provide information on:

- finding a supervisor for your PhD project and approaching possible supervisors
- getting enrolled as a doctoral student
- submitting applications at the faculties' doctorate committees and examination offices, as well as graduate centres
- semester contributions and rematriculation
- other administrative issues

#### Our counselling includes advice on:

- legal and financial aspects: visa and resident permits, scholarships, funding, living and working in Germany
- health insurance
- finding and changing accommodation
- language courses
- social and individual issues

Our student mentors will also accompany you to appointments with the Immigration Office and on similar occasions, such as meetings with prospective flat mates and landlords.

## Workshops & Lectures

We organise workshops and lectures to help you develop your competences and complete your doctoral degree.

Our workshops cover numerous topics:

- applying for scholarships and other possibilities of acquiring funding
- finding a job and preparing for job interviews –
   both during and at the end of your studies
