

Data privacy information

Justus Liebig University Giessen (JLU) processes your personal data for the purpose of documenting events and carrying out public relations work. The legal basis is Art. 6. (1) (e) of the European General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

Photographs or recordings of your person may be published in 'uniforum', on the JLU website or in other media and be previously passed on by those members of staff at JLU or other bodies who/which require such material for the performance of their duties. The photographs and recordings remain stored for as long as is necessary for fulfilment of the said purposes.

You are entitled at any time to request information about the photographs or recordings and thus the collected personal data concerning yourself and have incorrect data corrected or the processing of this data restricted (Art. 15, 16 and 18 GDPR). If you consider data processing to be unlawful, you may lodge a complaint with the Hessian Data Protection Officer (Art. 77 GDPR, Section 55 of the Hessian Data Protection and Freedom of Information Act ("Hessisches Datenschutz-und Informationsfreiheitsgesetz"). You may object to the further processing of personal data (Art. 21 GDPR) on grounds relating to your particular situation.
