### Funding

TUITION: ERASMUS scholarship > no tuition fees

### Accommodation

PRIVATE: There are several types of accommodation:

Apartments (preferred by both Erasmus students and the students in Izmir). Monthly cost of rent is about 250-450 €.

Shared flat for 120-150 €, including water, power, and internet.

DORMS: Application forms for dormitories are sent upon request.

Private student dorms which cost about 250-350 € (bills included). Generally, they provide breakfast. The laundry system is similar to the one in Giessen dorms. The regulations about entrance hours are different and might be strict (such as informing the administration about staying out for the night or planning to return to the dorm late at night). The rooms are furnished.

### Other Costs

Visa + Residence Permit (to apply for in Izmir one month within arrival): about 100 €

Food: 150 €, Health insurance: 80 cents per day, 160 days = 128 € (TKK), Public Transport: 0-50 €, Hobbies and Leisure Time: 100-200 €, Books: 50 €/semester (All prices in Euro are subject to exchange rates)
