English language skills: A proof of English language skills is required. Either a TOEFL score (single test date) ≥ 79 (internet-based test), IELTS overall band score ≥ 6.5 , College English Test (CET) Band 6 (total score ≥ 450) or an equivalent English qualification (Abitur: minimum Grade 10 in English).

TUITION: Partner University > no tuition fees

Accommodation

PRIVATE: The University of Hong Kong offers support to help you finding a private place.

DORMS: Costs: WS 22/23: 10100 HK\$ (ca. 1300 €) per Semester; Double Room, internet, electricity, water, usage of Common Room facilities (kitchen, fridge, etc.); you have to buy bedsheets, pillow, blanket, etc. depending on the room types (single room; double room; etc.).

→ for a single room a medical certificate is needed stating why you are in need of living alone

Other Costs

Visa (approx. 600 HK\$ ~ 78 €)

Health Insurance: 290 € (ADAC). Air condition: 10 € per week, Laundry Machine Usage: 1 € per Machine, Student Octopus Card (Subway Transportation): Application around 20 €, every single ride is charged on card. (Prepaid Card)

VISA PROCEDURE: The university offers help in applying for a visa. Useful to apply through university itself. Recommended to apply at least 3 months in advance in order to avoid further costs. 600 HK\$ administrative fee. A helpful website is http://www.cityu.edu.hk/geo/ies_stdvisa.htm
