### Funding

Tuition: ERASMUS scholarship > no tuition fees

### Accommodation

#### Private:

- Shared flat (3 students): approx. 330 €
  - including water and gas
  - not included internet access (25 € per month)
- private flat approx. 500-600 €
  - including additional costs (electricity, water...)
  - found via easystanza.it
- Privately owned apartment/small house approx. 800 €
  - including household expenses, internet, parking
  - found via AirBnB
- Single room in a cottage with 3 other girls: 400€
  - Including Everything (Wi-Fi, Gas, Water etc.)
  - found through the website “cerco alloggio” and the university’s accommodation service

#### Dorms:

- Accommodation Service provided by University: approx. 350-500 €
