PRIVATE:

- Private room in a shared flat: 290 €
- Apartment via AirBnB: 388 €
 - o all costs included
- Private accommodation, shared apartment. 380€
 - o excluding utilities which are around 40-90€ per month
 - Found through various facebook groups, like "Erasmus Accommodation Vilnius 2023" or "Accommodations Vilnius"

DORMS:

- Shared flat in a student dormitory: 58-86 € per month
- Shared room in a dormitory: 82 € per month
 - including electricity, heating, water and fresh bed sheets, shared bathroom (5 students) and kitchen (ca. 20 students)
- Triple room in a dormitory: 58 €
 - o plus 8 € internet per month and 60 € security deposit
- Shared dormitory in an apartment: 61€ + security deposit of 110 €
 - including water, heating, electricity, bed sheets

Language course "Survival Lithuanian" is offered for 2 weeks before the start of the semester.1.5 hours per day, 2 CP

Preparatory language course in Kaunas offered by the University for free.

If you stay longer than 3 months, you have to register at the migration office. There you will have to pay 6€ and need some paperwork. The university helps a lot with the process (step-by-step guide).

In Lithuania, one course does not equal one session. Most of the times, this means 1,5h lecture PLUS 1,5h of seminar per week (some seminars are every two weeks, some lectures offer them only 4 times a semester). You cannot really tell beforehand but it is easy to sign out.

Lithuanian Language Course A1 is 3 times per week.

Lithuania is not as cheap as one might think. If you do not stay at one of the university dorms, rent and food can be costly. Hygiene products can be pricey, too.
