1. Submit your application to the SAO, deadline in December
2. Selection process and nomination by the end of December/beginning of January
3. Nomination at your host university (SAO)
4. Contact with host university (Acceptance Letter, etc.)

December of the year preceding study stay abroad; precise deadline to be announced on our webpage.

### Application at Host Uni:

Submit application form (online), learning agreement, transcript of records and proof of language skills.

### Accommodation:

**PRIVATE:** Stay with a Belgian family together with two other Erasmus students: 350 € per room including water, electricity, heating and internet. Generally, it is recommended to start searching for private accommodations far in advance (April, May). The easiest way is to join Facebook groups in which Belgian students offer their rooms when they go abroad themselves. ("Te huur: Kot in Gent")

**DORMS:** Student Residence: Single room with bath, shared kitchen, including water, electricity and heating, provision of bed linen, cleaning of the common spaces, repair service, use of telephone (you can only receive calls or call for free within the university system) and internet = approximately 454 euros + deposit 160 euros.

Extra payment: laundry room (5 Euros per machine)

### Funding:

**TUITION:** ERASMUS scholarship > no tuition fees

**OTHER COSTS:** Train ticket for 3 months within the area of Gent and Antwerpen: 140 €. Other option: renting a bike for 20 Euros for 3 months, deposit: 60 Euros; Language courses: 50 Euros for one language course, any next course more expensive.
