

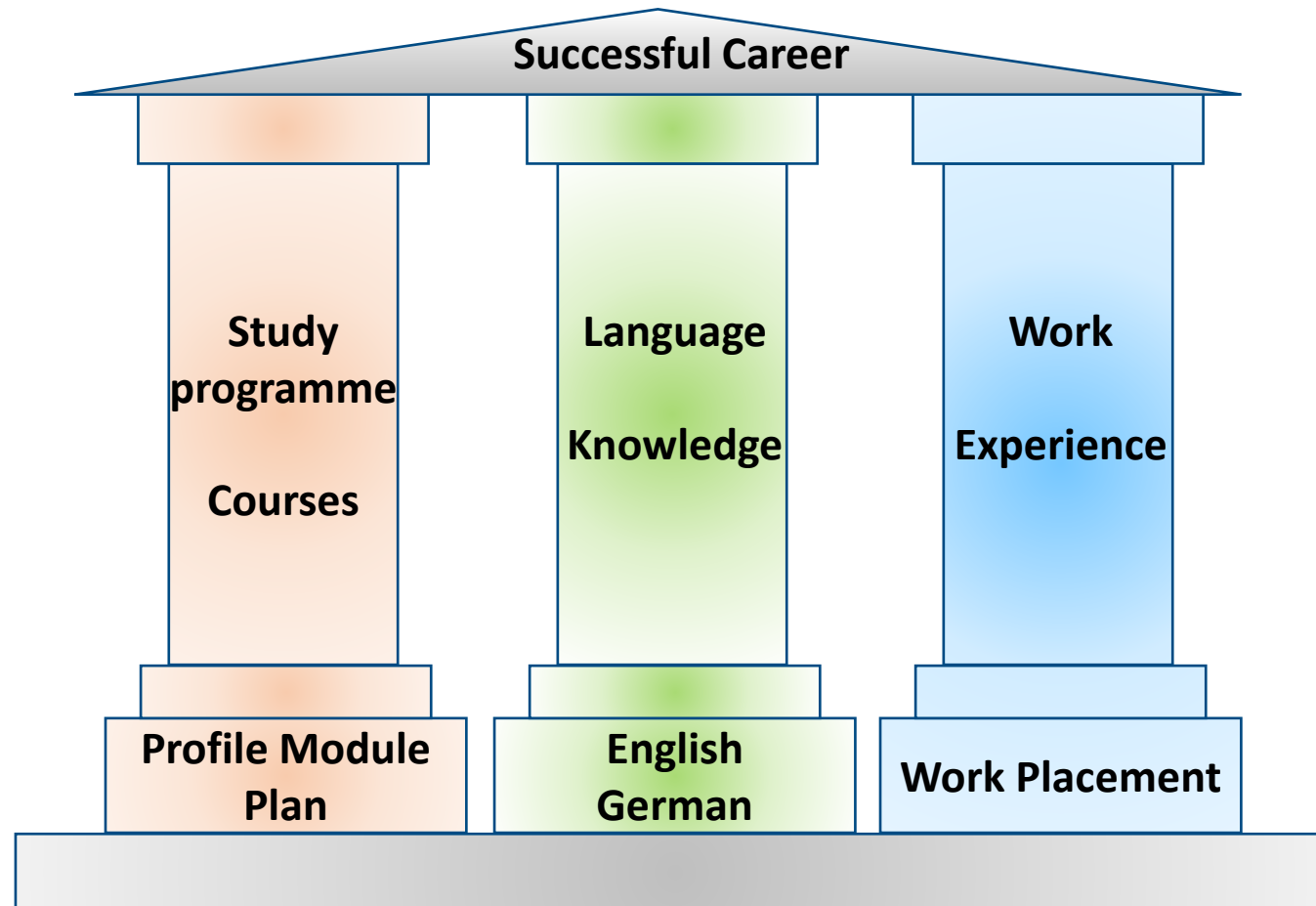

Profile module

Profile module = free choice



Optional

Registration for Participation in a Module

- **All Modules** have to be registered by the students
- **WHERE: in StudIP**
- during the **current semester** for the upcoming semester

Core Module VS Profile Module

- **Core module** – the seat is guaranteed in core modules of your programme
- **Profile module** – seats are (often) limited

Increase your chances for a seat in a limited course!

Preliminary distribution of seats

- a preliminary assignment of seats by the study deanery in StudIP
- Infos and time schedule → Internet and via mail from the study deanery

Profile Module Plan – Why?

- Planning of the programme → When do I attend which module?
- Reasonable module combinations → academic counselling
- Important for the distribution of seats (limited modules)
- Profile module plan has to be created and updated **in FlexNow**

Profile Module Plan

- At the end of the 1st semester
- No core modules of your programme → [recommended study schedule](#)
- Check the overlap of courses → [timetable](#)
- Check prerequisites for a module → [Module directory](#)
- Certain period for changes in FlexNow → [Sheet deadlines and dates](#)
- After a **registration for examination** the module **cannot** be changed again.

Changing the Profile Module Plan

- modules can be exchanged (almost) always
- changes are **not possible during the registration period for exams**

FlexNow is open either for exam registration **or** for the profile module plan

→ You cannot perform both transactions within the same time slot.

- after the **1st registration for an examination** no changes are possible

- Work Placement MP-196 (equals two profile modules)
- Core modules of other degree programmes (at max 4 modules)
- Modules of other faculties (at max. 5 modules)



Distribution of Module seats

Profile Modules with limited seats:

- on the basis of the profile module plan
- students in higher semesters are considered first
- students of the same semester are chosen by lot

- students register directly in Stud.IP
