SELECTION PROCEDURE, CRITERIA, DEADLINES FOR APPLICATION

1. Be enrolled in an undergraduate program at the University of Antioquia.
2. Have completed 50% of the credits for the current undergraduate program.
3. Have academic endorsement from your academic program.
4. For the purposes of this call, you must have a cumulative grade point average of 4.0 or higher in the program.
5. Be proficient in English or German at level B2 (depending on the language in which the courses of interest are offered at JLU Giessen).
6. Have no disciplinary sanctions in the last two years.
7. Belong to socioeconomic strata 1, 2, or 3.
8. In addition to the provisions of section 6, positive consideration will be given to students who belong to the population considered to have "fewer opportunities," according to European Union criteria:
 - Students with disabilities.
 - Students with chronic illnesses.
 - Students who are the first in their family to access higher education.
 - Students who work to finance their university studies.
7. Have a minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.

DOCUMENTS TO HAND IN WITH THE APPLICATION

1. Endorsement from the academic department to develop the academic exchange abroad. This letter must contain the subjects that the student will take at the host university and that will be recognized upon their return.
2. Photocopy of valid passport.
3. Letter of motivation addressed to the International Relations Office, in which the student states the following (maximum one and a half pages, in Arial 11 and single spacing):
 - A brief presentation of the candidate.
 - Statement of the academic reasons for pursuing the exchange.
 - Statement of personal reasons for pursuing the exchange.
 - A statement of the reasons for applying for the scholarship.
4. Transcript and credit certificate for the last semester, downloaded directly from the online certificate section of the university portal (check that it does not have the watermark "Not valid").
5. Certificate demonstrating proficiency in English or German at level B2 of the Common

European Framework (you may submit an exam or certificate issued by an international organization or a reputable language teaching institution. Some examples are: IELTS, TOEFL, TOEIC, Colombo Americano, British Council, Oxford placement test, Cambridge placement test, Humboldt-Institut, among others).

6. Copy of the latest utility bill showing socioeconomic status.

7. Student commitment letter.

8. Extracurricular activities and awards (submit the various certificates that support them):

- Participation in national or international academic events.
- Completion of academic courses.
- Participation in research.
- Honors or other recognition of academic excellence during undergraduate studies.
- SEA administrative assistant or monitor during undergraduate studies.
- Sports and/or artistic awards.

9. Certificates proving membership of a population considered to have fewer opportunities, according to European Union criteria:

- Students with disabilities.
- Students with chronic illnesses.
- Students who are the first in their family to access higher education.
- Students who work to finance their university studies.

RECOGNITION PROCEDURE FOR CREDITS COMPLETED ABROAD

At UdeA, the recognition of credits completed abroad is carried out directly by each academic unit, in accordance with our institutional principle of university autonomy.

Before the mobility, students receive an initial endorsement from their academic unit for the proposed study plan. Upon return, the same unit reviews the actual Transcript of Records and proceeds with the formal recognition of courses following its internal procedures and academic regulations.
