The interview panel is chaired by the academic contact ERASMUS+ at HU.

RECOGNITION PROCEDURE FOR CREDITS COMPLETED ABROAD

Please describe, if and how credits completed abroad are recognized at your university and who is in charge of recognition (International Office or the individual Departments).

Courses and degree/diploma earned abroad will be submitted to the Federal Ministry of

Education to establish the equivalence and eventually get approval/recognition in accordance with Ethiopian higher education regulations.

However, credits earned from student exchange programs undertaken by two partnering higher education institutions shall be determined at university level on case-by-case level. Hence, course equivalence shall be proposed by department level and sent to the affiliated colleges for review and approval. Then, College Academic Commission will be sent to the Academic Vice President for final approval.

Upon completion of the mobility program students are expected to submit

- **List of courses/seminars taken while studying abroad**
- **Certificate for the Grades Courses/Seminars taken in the partner institution**
- **In case, the mobility student extended her/his stay in partner institution, s/he should provide a written justification for the extension unless the extension is approved by her/his department and college.**
