SELECTION PROCEDURE, CRITERIA, DEADLINES FOR APPLICATION

Please list here your selection criteria for applicants (based on grading, recommendation, overall application etc.) as well as your application deadlines for different calls

- The Deputy Director responsible for community engagement and internationalisation prepares a call.
- The call is presented by the Deputy Director to the Community engagement and Internationalisation sub-committee of the school management committee for input.
- The final call is then presented to the school management committee.
- The school management committee considers and approves the call
- Once approved, the call is circulated by the Admin Assistants across the three campuses through emails and the Learning Management System.
- The students who need further information communicate via email to the admin assistants.
- Applications are received by an admin assistant.
- A summary of the applications is presented by the Deputy Director to the Community engagement and Internationalisation sub-committee of the school management committee.
- The school management committee considers and approves applications based on merit.
- The students who meet the requirement are identified.
- All applicants receive feedback, whether approved or not, from the committee.
- Those who receive the bursary are introduced to the JLU colleagues and guided throughout the process.

- **Certified copy of a valid passport.**
