Procedure: Students must complete and be accepted to the UW-Milwaukee study abroad application for the JLU-Giessen exchange program. JLU-Giessen Erasmus+ scholarship materials are included in the online study abroad application as optional supplemental materials. Students who meet eligibility requirements for the program and submit the Erasmus+ scholarship materials with their application are considered for the scholarship.

Successful completion of **JLU-Giessen Erasmus+ Scholarship requirements** (included in study abroad application materials as optional forms to submit):

- Meeting Erasmus+ eligibility criteria
- Resume
- Motivational statement
- Top-up supplementary scholarship affidavit form (optional)

Successful completion of and acceptance to **UW-Milwaukee study abroad application** for the JLU-Giessen exchange program:

- Minimum GPA 3.0
- Sophomore, Junior, Senior, or Graduate standing
- 4 semesters German language or equivalent
- \$100 study abroad application fee
- 1 advisor conference form
- 1 academic recommendation
- Student statement
- Unofficial UWM transcript
- Language Evaluation conducted by the UWM German Department
- Copy of a valid passport (or proof of purchase/receipt)
- Read and e-sign required documents

Deadlines:

- March 1 (summer/fall/academic year cycle)
- October 1 (spring cycle)
