Weather

Evening program at the Alt Giessen on Wednesday and the Dach Café on Friday

The conference warming will take place at 7pm at a local brewery called Alt Giessen, which is about 15 minutes on foot from the conference hotel and 10 minutes from the conference venue. If you are only arriving at the hotel after this time, please do still join us — we'll have plenty of food and drinks ready for you ;-)!
