The Jean-Pictet Competition is the largest and most prestigious Humanitarian Law moot court Competition. It takes place every year in a new country usually between February and March. Over the course of one week, around 48 teams from the five continents will be assigned different roles, solve controversial legal issues, and experience a fictional armed conflict.

- Good knowledge of Public International Law or Humanitarian Law will be an asset
