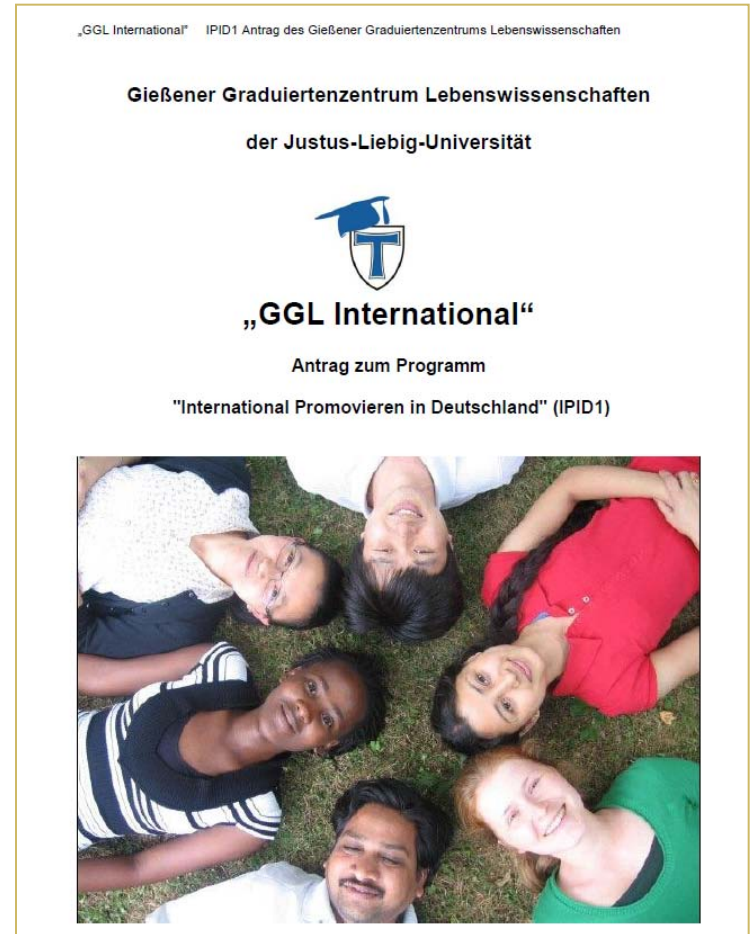

The IPID Program of the DAAD

- The GGL has been able to secure a grant within the IPID 1 Programm of the DAAD (German Academic Research Service)
- IPID = International Promovieren in Deutschland (Acquire an international doctoral degree in Germany)
- The Aim of IPID 1 is to promote attractive international doctoral programmes within Germany through interesting international opportunities.

What Will Be Funded

Per year Available

Lab Exchange Services

- Travel costs: in total 35 GGL members
- Subsidies for living costs: in total 35 GGL members

What Will Be Funded

Per year available

German language courses

- Intensive courses: 360,- € for 32 GGL members
- Evening courses: 100 ,- € for 32 GGL members

Integration services

For new arrivals and international party: 2300,- €
per year

Guest speaker programme

Subsidies for 8 international speakers in total 4.720,- €

GGL International Co-ordinator

- Build lab exchange database
- Search for new partner labs
- Co-ordinate selection procedure
- Co-ordinate integration services
- Administer grants
- Build new international contacts with other graduate schools

Lab Exchange Services – Conditions

- GGL members only
- Contributing groups to the IPID application will be preferred
- Only lab stays will be funded – no conferences
- Only **up to 30 days** will be funded
- Applications through the GGL will be possible after **April, 15th**
- Fixed rates regulated by the DAAD will be granted

Lab Exchange Services – Criteria

- Competitive Grants -> Application and Selection Procedure

- Selection will be made using the following criteria:
 - 1) Quality of the host lab, institution or company
 - 2) Quality of your work plan
 - 3) Significance of the lab exchange for your project
 - 4) Potential for your career
 - 5) Potential of a sustainable collaboration between the GGL and your host organisation
 - 6) Availability of funds within your own lab

What to Include in Your Application

- Where you want to go
- Who you want to link with
- When you want to go
- Subject area and title of your research topic
- What you want to do there (programme for the visit)
- Why this research is important
- Why it should be you that is given the award

What to Include in Your Application

- How the link will benefit the GGL network
- How your visit will help build international connections
- How the link will be sustained after your stay
- How your visit will help you in your career development
- After the visit: a research summary in plain English

Examples

| City | Country | Travel costs | Subsidies (for 30 days) | total(EUR) |
|-------------|----------------|---------------------|------------------------------------|-------------------|
| New York | USA (East) | 1000,- | 375,- | 1375,- |
| Sydney | Australia | 1100,- | 375,- | 1475,- |

| Utrecht | Netherlands | 175,- | 125,10 | 300,10 |

| Paris | France | 125,- | 350,10 | 475,10 |
| Oslo | Norway | 200,- | 450,00 | 650,00 |
| Moskau | Russia | 300,- | 300,00 | 600,00 |

Language Courses

- Competitive Grants -> Simple Application and Selection Procedure:
 - 1) Intensive courses for newcomers first
 - 2) After that first come, first serve
 - 3) Per person a maximum of one intensive course and one evening course
