#### Objectives

The participants are able to

- ... clarify their role as professional teachers
- ... design a course or a single lesson with a focus on students learning
- ... set learning goals that focus on deeper learning of their students
- ... develop meaningful learning activities to prepare their students to reach the goals
- ... choose didactical methods that fit learning goals and participants
- ... identify opportunities for frequent and specific feedback on learning
- ... use media to deliver content in a didactical meaningful way (board, flipchart , ppt etc) to deliver content
- ... initiate and moderate discussions for didactical purpose

#### Content

Teaching means to be in contact with learners - to deal with their expectations and to address their needs. The more you know about basics of teaching and learning - the better you will be able to meet all relevant didactical requirements.

The workshop provides you with the basics of professional teaching competence like developing a role concept for teaching, how to set learning goals, create learning activities and communicate with your students.

You will learn how to design courses that focus on students' learning by using a method of integrative course design. This method considers the mutual dependence between learning goals, learning activities and feedback - and thus furthers deep learning. You will put the first steps of the method into practice, using your course conception.

**Please note:** This workshop is the first of two modules. Module 2 will take place in September. Then you will have the opportunity to present your teaching concept to other participants and the trainer and you will receive feedback for improvement.
