## What is Model United Nations?

Model United Nations (MUN) is a simulation of the United Nations. Students take on the role of diplomats, discuss current topics and work on resolutions in different UN Committees. The conferences are held in English and take place all over the world. During the winter semester of 2023/24, we will be preparing a new delegation from Giessen University to be sent to **National Model United Nations in New York (NMUN)** in March/April 2024.

## Why should you apply?

By participating in the project, you can broaden your knowledge on public international law with practical insights into the world of diplomacy. You can learn more about the history, work and main fields of work of the United Nations, while improving your rhetorical and negotiating skills. The conference is also a platform for meeting other students from different countries.

## Who can participate?

Students from all faculties who are interested in international politics and the United Nations are welcome to apply. Law students will be able to acquire a *Fremdsprachenschein* or *Schlüsselqualifikation* and the preparatory colloquium is further considered a *Wahlveranstaltung* for *Schwerpunktbereich 6* (International Law and European Law). You can find detailed selection criteria on the website of Prof. Marauhn under Model United Nations.

## Preparation

Mandatory, in-person weekly colloquium in English, and participation in SiegMUN and/or MainMUN as well as a mandatory study trip to Berlin.

## Costs

Co-payment is anticipated to be around 500€, in exceptional cases further assistance can be provided.



From 15. - 17.09.2023, GiMUN e.V. will organize GiMUN, which is our very own MUN Conference taking place in Giessen. All interested high school and university students are welcome to apply in English to [ModelUN@recht.uni-giessen.de](mailto:ModelUN@recht.uni-giessen.de) by 01.09.2023, stating your name, study subject and semester of study, as well as committee preference (if any - General Assembly (beginner) or Security Council (intermediate)), experience with other MUN conferences (if any), and consent to have pictures of you taken and published during GiMUN.

GiMUN will also be an integral part of the application process for the NMUN team and all the delegation applicants are required to participate in GiMUN.
