2.	<p>Faculty 05 Language, Literature, Culture</p> <p>German Studies</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Germanic Linguistics (b) Germanic Literature (c) German as a Foreign Language <p>The state examination for high school teachers (<i>Gymnasium</i>) in German shall be the equivalent of a degree in the doctoral subject of Germanic Linguistics or Germanic Literature.</p> <p>The degree for the doctoral subject of German as a Foreign Language shall be awarded on the basis of the graduate course in German as a Foreign Language with a degree (<i>Diplom</i>) as a teacher of foreign languages (German as a Foreign Language), the supplementary subject of German as a Foreign Language for high school teachers (<i>Gymnasium</i>) and a degree in German Studies from a non-German-speaking university, which is the equivalent of an MA or a Master's degree from a German university.</p> <p>English Studies</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) English Language Studies (b) English and American Literature (c) Didactics of English Language and Literature (d) English and American Cultural Studies <p>The state examination for high school teachers (<i>Gymnasium</i>) in English and <i>Diplom</i> (first degree) examination in Modern/Applied Foreign Languages with English Studies as the main or subsidiary subject shall be the equivalent of a degree in the doctoral subject of English Language Studies and English and American Literature.</p> <p>The <i>Diplom</i> (first degree) examination in Modern/Applied Foreign Languages with the same subsidiary subject, an MA in "Modern Foreign Languages and the Didactics of Foreign Languages" or the state examination for high school teachers (<i>Gymnasium</i>) shall be the equivalent of a degree in the doctoral subject of the Didactics of English Language and Literature.</p>
