

Assignment of undergraduate degree programmes at Justus Liebig University Giessen to Studienkolleg specialisation courses

To study in Germany, you must apply with sufficient educational qualifications, such as a school-leaving certificate or university degree. Not all applicants have a direct university entrance qualification (*Hochschulzugangsberechtigung*, HZB) and are required to attend a Studienkolleg (www.studienkollegs.de). If this applies to you, you must submit your application through uni-assist (<https://www.uni-giessen.de/en/international-pages/study/application/>).

Depending on your chosen field of study, you will be assigned to a specialisation course at the Studienkolleg Mittelhessen:

M course (medicine, dentistry, veterinary medicine, biology and other medical, biological subjects)
