Deregistrations from examinations are possible up to **the third day before** the examination date without giving reasons. Within the three-day period, only **withdrawal** from the examination in accordance with § 29 AIB is possible. Please declare this in writing, stating your reasons, to the chair of the relevant examination board or the Natural Sciences Examination Office. If the withdrawal is due to **illness**, please use the certificate of incapacity for examination.

If you are unable to take an examination due to illness but meet the requirements for deregistration, this form is sufficient; in this case, it is not necessary to submit a medical certificate.

If you have not completed the **preliminary examination requirements** for the relevant module, it is not necessary to deregister from the examination.
