

APPLY VIA UNI-ASSIST

- For programmes with open admission:
September 15, 2022
- For programmes with restricted admission:
July 15, 2022
- For the programmes “Transition Management”, “Agrobiotechnology” and “Insect Biotechnology and Bioresources”:
August 31, 2022
- For the programme “Mind, Brain and Behaviour”:
July 15, 2022

ARRANGE FOR FUNDING

- Financial proof of ca. 930 € per month / ca. 11.200 € per year, e.g.:
- Blocked bank account
- Grant by a public institution
- Student loan
- Part-time job
- Letter of financial commitment (from a person living in Germany)

RESIDENCE PERMIT

- Apply for visa until August 31, 2022 or within 90 days after entering Germany
- Show proof that you have applied for studies or for a German intensive course in preparation for academic study
- As soon as you are enrolled at JLU or admitted to a German course, submit your enrolment certificate or admission to a German course to the Immigration Authorities
