


## The City of Giessen

**Giessen is a city with an approx. population of 86.000. It's located in the middle of the federal country Hesse, besides the River Lahn and a county and court seat. It's famous for it's academical status, besides the Justus-Liebig-University (JLU) and the TH Mittelhessen University of Applied Sciences (THM). There are more than 37.000 students enrolled at the moment. This makes Giessen the city with the highest density of students in Germany (43 % of the population are students). A large part of the old town of Giessen was destroyed during World War II, only few of the historical buildings remained in the city centre like the New Palace (Neues Schloss) where the Department of Geography is located. The 'Seltersweg' is kind of a Giessen's shopping street where you can find everything you need.**

At the Market Square (green H) most buslines of the Giessen Bus Service (SWG) have a regular stop.




This symbol marks a busstop.

## Liniennetzplan




**Route map of the Giessen Bus Service (Bus lines). The nearest bus stop to the Department of Geography is 'Marktplatz' (Market Square).**
